

# FLY-IN SAFARI

## EXCLUSIVE NAMIBIA TO VICTORIA FALLS 2022

15 DAYS / 14 NIGHTS



More than just a holiday, a visit to Namibia is a transformative journey through time, a return to the source of life. Eternal, immense, grandiose, fascinating, a genuine kaleidoscope of colours... no adjective can easily describe Namibia. To visit this country is to experience an unforgettable feeling of freedom and change of scenery.

Combine the desert scenery of Namibia, with the green oasis of Chobe and the thundering wall of water in Victoria falls! The accommodation is carefully chosen to discover the diversity of landscapes, wildlife and activities these regions of Southern Africa have on offer.

Day 01 :

**WINDHOEK / SESRIEM (approx. 1h10 flight)**

Arrival at Windhoek International Airport (no later than 14h00). Meet and greet with your English-speaking pilot, and our representative who will hand over your travel documents and discuss the itinerary with you giving you a first taste of what you may expect during your visit. Depart on your private flight to the Namib Desert where your lodge is situated on a private nature reserve close to Sossusvlei. Depending on the time of arrival, you can enjoy a first non-private activity on the lodge's private reserve or the stunning view on desert landscape.

Day 02 :

**SESRIEM / SOSSUSVLEI / SESRIEM**

**Breakfast**

The best time to visit this magical place is from sunrise, and you depart from the lodge about 45 minutes before sunrise to be one time to enter as soon as it opens after sunrise with guide and 4x4 vehicle of your lodge. Enjoy the spectacular sight or some of the highest dunes in the world and the morning colours of the Namib Desert. Before returning to your lodge, visit the Sesriem Canyon, a natural gorge carved millions of years ago by the once mighty Tsauchab River. In the afternoon depart on a nature drive or scenic guided walk (not private) on the lodge property to discover more desert scenery.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Sossusvlei Desert Lodge \*\*\*\*/\*\*\*\*\***



*Previously inaccessible, as part of the restricted diamond zone, **Sossusvlei** was opened to the public in 1977. The splendour of the Namib Desert is accessible here, filled with a breathtaking sea of dunes. Giant dunes, amongst the highest in the world, some of them up to 300m high. Dunes as far as the eye can see, wild and romantic. All the colours, all the ochres, all the mauves are revealed according to the path of the sun, from pink to purple, from pale orange to bright red, from apricot to blood red.*

Day 03 :

**SESRIEM / HOANIB (approx. 3h10 flight & 1 stop of approx. 30 minutes in Swakopmund to refuel & 02h00 transfer by road to the lodge)**

**Breakfast**

Before departing to the north why not to spoil yourself with a hot air balloon over the desert just after sunrise (optional activity). It is also possible to explore the unique desert environment by taking part in last morning activity with the lodge (included, not private). Afterwards, your scenic flight takes you over the dunes, old diamond mining camps and beached boats to Swakopmund. After a quick stopover for refuelling, continue your flight into Damaraland. A scenic transfer to the charming accommodation (about 1.5 and 2 hours) gives you a glimpse of the fascinating flora and fauna of the region.

*The **Hoanib Valley** is an oasis in one of Africa's most spectacular deserts. Wildlife such as desert elephant, giraffe, zebra, lion and rhino roam freely in this vast, mountainous, wild landscape. Hoanib Valley Camp is situated on the bank of the Obias River, overlooking the Hoanib River Valley. This valley fluctuates between seasonal river flows through grassy, spring plains or dry sandy riverbeds where many elephants reside. Hoanib Valley Camp is 'clean and green', leaving virtually no footprint on this fragile ecosystem. The camp was built in a partnership with the Sesfontein community.*

Day 04 :

## DISCOVER THE HOANIB REGION

### Breakfast

The day is devoted purely to the discovery of the area through the activities offered by the camp (not private), with an English-speaking guide from the camp:

- Excursion by 4x4 in search of rhinos (very early start!)
- Meeting the Herero community,
- Guided walk
- Excursion in search of the wildlife of this region such as desert elephants, giraffes, oryx, baboons, springboks, ...

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at HOANIB VALLEY CAMP \*\*\*\***



Day 05 :

## HOANIB / HARTMANN VALLEY (about 1.5 hours flight)

### Breakfast

After breakfast you fly north to the Kunene region bordering Angola. Your exclusive accommodation is built on the bank of Kunene River creating a dream landscape for photographers and nature lovers alike. Here you have the afternoon to explore the valley on one of the activities included in your package.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Camp Serra Cafema \*\*\*\*/\*\*\*\*\* - [www.wilderness-safaris.com](http://www.wilderness-safaris.com)**



Day 06 :

## HARTMANN VALLEY

### Breakfast

Today you will discover the area through the activities offered by the lodge (not private), with an English-speaking guide from the lodge:

- Quad biking excursion (approx. 3 hours) to discover the great landscapes of the Hartmann Valley.
- Boat trip (on a small motorboat) on the Kunene River for bird watching and possibility to see crocodiles. The duration of this trip depends on the water level of the river and can vary from 1 to 2 hours
- Excursion in a 4x4 vehicle in the Hartmann Valley for at least 3 hours
- Guided visit of Himba village
- Guided scenic walk

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Camp Serra Cafema \*\*\*\*/\*\*\*\*\***

Day 07 :

## HARTMANN VALLEY / ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK (approx. 2 hours flight & 30 minutes stop at Ondangwa to refuel)

### Breakfast

You may end your stay with the last non-private morning activity of your choice before you embark on a flight to the private Onguma Reserve situated on the border of Etosha National Park. In the late afternoon enjoy a guided, non-private sunset game drive on the lodge's game reserve.

Day 08 :

## ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

### Breakfast

The cooler morning time is when you have the most chance of meeting lion, leopards, or other predators. An early wake-up allows for a departure just before sunrise for a half day of safari in the Etosha National Park with the guide and 4x4 vehicle of the lodge. Etosha offers one of the world's most beautiful wildlife encounters. The Park covers more than 20,000 km<sup>2</sup> where we find 114 species of mammals and 340 varieties of birds. Afternoon is devoted to new game viewing experience on the lodge's private reserve.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Onguma The Fort \*\*\*\***

*Etosha National Park, whose name means "great white space", is located in the northwest of Namibia and is the largest park in Namibia. It is one of the country's main attractions, along with the Namib Desert. You can see a wide variety of wildlife, offering one of the world's most beautiful wildlife spectacles. It covers more than 20,000 km<sup>2</sup>, it is home to 114 species of mammals, 340 species of birds of which about a third are migratory and 110 species of reptiles. The fauna is attracted by perennial water sources as well as man-made watering holes. During the dry season, their gathering around these areas provides good photographic opportunities. The vegetation is varied: from dense bush to wide open plains, it attracts an exceptional diversity of wildlife, and provides a variety of different landscapes, changing as you move through the reserve. At the heart of the park is a vast area of land 120km long and 72km wide: Pan, which means dry water, was originally an inland sea, which over time became a salt lake and then dried up about 12 million years ago.*

Day 09 :

## ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK / ZAMBEZI REGION (about 2h35 flight)

### Breakfast

In the morning you meet with your safari guide who will take you for another game drive in Etosha Park (not private). No game drive is the same; all waterholes hold new surprises and attract different animal species that you may not have seen previously. The room must be vacated prior to the game drive. After safari you fly north into Namibia's Zambezi region known as a birding hot spot.

### END OF THE SERVICES OF YOUR PILOT UPON ARRIVAL IN KONGOLA

After check-in to the charming lodge that lies on one of Okavango riverbanks you will enjoy your first activity with the lodge (game drive, boat ride or sunset walk).

Day 10 :

## DISCOVERY OF BWABWATA PARK (KONGOLA)

### Breakfast

An unforgettable nature experience is guaranteed since you spend the day in search for the wildlife and birds in this marshy area, in the Namibian bush.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Nambwa Tented Lodge \*\*\*\***

Day 11 :

## ZAMBEZI REGION (KONGOLA) / CHOBE NATIONAL PARK (250 km > about 4h30 drive)

### Breakfast

After breakfast you leave Namibia and travel by road to Botswana where you join the luxury safari boat Chobe Princess. This luxury safari boat allows you to be in proximity of wildlife especially huge herds of elephants and to enjoy the beautiful African sunsets on the Chobe River.

**Included: Picnic lunch en route, Dinner and overnight on the Chobe Princess superior cabin \*\*\*\* - [www.zgcollection.com](http://www.zgcollection.com)**



Day 12 :

## CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

### Breakfast

Today is dedicated to the tranquil observation of the local fauna and flora. The presence of large animals is guaranteed thanks to the river which brings them all together to drink.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight on the Chobe Princess superior cabin \*\*\*\***

*Surrounded by the delta to the west and the eponymous river to the north, **Chobe National Park** is Botswana's second largest wildlife park. Home to probably the largest concentration of elephants in the world, it represents the ultimate African desert savannah. The Savute dry swamps southwest of Chobe are home to a wide variety of carnivores known for their intense activity. The major migration routes run right through Chobe.*


Day 13 :

## CHOBE NATIONAL PARK / VICTORIA FALLS (90 km > about 2h30 drive)

### Breakfast

With unforgettable safari boat memories, you will discover the Chobe National Park in open safari vehicle this morning. Then a transfer takes you to the town of Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe, famous for one of the most spectacular natural wonders Victoria falls. Your afternoon is at leisure to enjoy the surroundings or to participate in one of the non-private activities included in your stay such as a game drive, a boat trip on the Zambezi River,...

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Victoria Falls River Lodge \*\*\*\* - [www.victoriafallsriverlodge.com](http://www.victoriafallsriverlodge.com)**



Day 14 :

## VICTORIA FALLS

### Breakfast

This morning you join a guided excursion to discover Victoria Falls on foot (not private). Before returning to lodge, you will experience the Falls by helicopter for about 12 minutes (not private). Rest of the afternoon is at leisure to enjoy the surroundings or participate in one of the non-private activities included in your stay.

**Included: Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Victoria Falls River Lodge \*\*\*\***

***Victoria Falls** is one of the most spectacular waterfalls in the world. It is located on the Zambezi River, which at this point forms the border between Zambia, near the town of Livingstone, and Zimbabwe. The river flows into the cataract over a width of about 1,700 metres and a height of up to 108 metres. It is possible to visit the falls during the day, or a few days a month in the evening during the full moon.*

Day 15 :

## VICTORIA FALLS / DEPARTURE

### Breakfast

After breakfast you are transferred to Victoria Falls International Airport for your departure flight.
